<u>abandoned</u> -VERB having been left behind, usually purposely; deserted; having been given up

ADJECTIVE discarded; dumped; vacated <abandoned car on the side of the road>

amazement- NOUN wonder and surprise; astonishment; sudden fear or fright

braced –VERB held stiff or tight, usually in preparation for an attack or blow; made secure, strong, or able to withstand attack; prepared for something difficult or threatening

ADJECTIVE stable; unmoving

fury -NOUN rage; extreme anger

loot- NOUN stolen valuables or goods; goods or money that is obtained illegally

<u>**nugget**</u> – NOUN a small, solid lump or chunk that does not have a definite or regular shape; a small bit or piece of something, usually a precious metal or material, such as gold

<u>plaster</u>-NOUN a mixture of water, sand, and gypsum used as a coating that hardens when dry

VERB the act of covering something in plaster

<u>rubble</u>- NOUN the remains of something that has been broken or destroyed; rough, broken stones; debris or wreckage

tattered - VERB tore; shredded

ADJECTIVE torn; ragged; having a used or well-worn appearance; showing signs of much wear or use
