almanac -NOUN a book or booklet containing weather predictions, moon phases, and other information for a given year

ambitious- ADJECTIVE having or showing a desire to succeed; hungry or eager for success, achievement, power, wealth, or distinction

autobiography -NOUN a book or piece of writing in which a person tells the story of his or her life; a life's story written or told by the person who has lived it

benefit -VERB to receive or give help, aid, or assistance; to gain or provide something useful
NOUN an advantage

compromise- NOUN an agreement, often requiring each participant to make a sacrifice; a mutual understanding; a settlement
VERB to settle on or agree upon by each party giving something up

delegate – NOUN a person sent or empowered to act for others; a person elected or appointed to represent others; an ambassador or representative
VERB to authorize and send (a person) to represent

founded –VERB took the first steps or measures in erecting or building up; established or instituted; set up; initiated; started; created; originated

generally- ADVERB mostly; usually; for the most part; most frequently; more often than not

proposed - VERB suggested; offered an idea; put forward or recommended
ADJECTIVE something recommended or suggested <a proposed building plan>
