grabbed VERB (past tense) snatched; seized; took hold of, often suddenly or with force

grove NOUN a small cluster of trees

invisible ADJECTIVE unable to be seen; unseen

lantern NOUN an enclosed lamp that often uses a small flame as its light source; a portable source of light with clear sides that reveal a glowing flame or bulb

loudly ADVERB in a noisy or bold way; not softly

mist NOUN a light fog; a haze formed by tiny droplets of water or other liquid

scroll NOUN a rolled-up piece of written material, such as paper or parchment
VERB- to navigate up or down on a computer

silently ADVERB without making any noise or sound; without speaking or saying anything; not out loud
