annoyed- VERB irritated; bothered or frustrated; aroused to impatience or anger; pestered; troubled; disturbed repeatedly or continuously; upset
ADJECTIVE: describes someone or something that is bothered or frustrated
<the *annoyed* traveler>

barber- NOUN someone who cuts, styles, or shaves hair for a living

contract- NOUN an agreement between two or more parties that is recognized by law

expedition- NOUN a trip to explore; a journey, quest, mission, or an exploration; a voyage; an excursion

manager- NOUN a person who directs, handles, or is in charge of the affairs or dealings of a company, business, group, or individual

remarks- NOUN casual statements, observations, or comments; statements that express opinions or beliefs; mentions

solemn- ADJECTIVE serious; somber; grave; quiet or sedate; stern; not lighthearted; not casual <my *solemn* vow>

toboggan- VERB to slide or move down a hill or over snow using a sled; to ride on or to use a long, narrow sled made of flat boards that curve upward in front
NOUN a long, narrow sled

tripod- NOUN a three-legged holder or stand, often for a camera

unfortunately- ADVERB unluckily; regrettably; unhappily or sadly; as bad luck would have it
